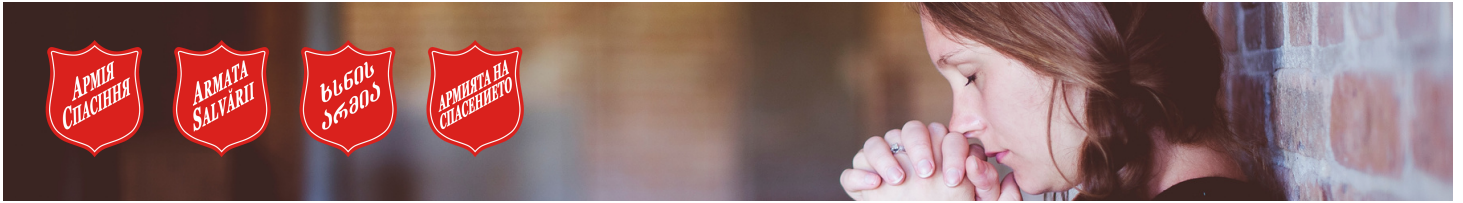


40 DAYS OF PRAYER
